## April is Sexual Violence Prevention Month for Young Adults

### Don't Become an Abuser or a Victim

Sexual abuse and violence are serious violations of human rights and will not be tolerated. In April, young adults are at a higher risk of facing sexual violence due to changes in environment such as starting at a new school or new workplace. As an opportunity to learn about having equal relationships with each other, the City holds lectures about date violence at the junior high schools. So that no one ends up becoming an abuser or victim, let's think about mutually respectful relationships within our families and our communities.



#### What preconceptions do you have about sexual abuse?

- *Only young women are victims of sexual violence.*

Men can also be victims of sexual violence. Regardless if the people involved are children or elderly, or if they are of the opposite sex or same sex, any sexual act done without consent is an act of sexual violence.

"They didn't say anything, so I thought it was okay."  
Those words and actions you weren't aware of might be hurting your partner.

Actions done to your partner without their consent is sexual violence.

- *Strangers attack victims when its late at night.*

Of course, while it is dangerous to stay out late at night, acts of violence triggered by social media can happen no matter the place or time of day. Acts of sexual violence may also be committed by people close to victim, such as friends, spouses, or lovers.

## New Law Preventing Sexual Violence in Schools Will Take Effect

In order to prevent sexual violence against children in school and preschool settings and to protect their mental and physical health, the Act on the Prevention of Sexual Violence Against Children (*Kodomo seibouryoku boushi hou*) will be implemented beginning December 25<sup>th</sup>, 2026. Educational or daycare institutions for children, such as schools, nurseries, kindergartens, after-school clubs, and cram schools, will be required to enforce active measures preventing sexual violence.

## Submit Your Child's Pre-Vaccination Questionnaire Easier Through the App!

The Vaccination Register and Screening Questionnaire will now be digitized, making it easier to fill it out and submit through the app. Starting in April for select medical providers, the screening questionnaires can be submitted by either paper or digital methods. ## **FY2026 Pneumococcus Regular Vaccination for Adults**

Pneumonia is one of the major causes of death amongst people in Japan, and approximately 98% of fatal cases are seniors aged 65 years old or above. By getting the pneumococcus vaccine to defend against the main pathogen that causes pneumonia, you can prevent your symptoms from becoming severe.

**Who is Eligible?:** Residents of Kyotango City who fall under one of the following groups:

### **Regular Vaccination:**

- 1) People who will be 65 years old *\*A notice will be sent individually in the mail the month after your birthday month.*
- 2) People ages 60 to 64 years old with compromised heart, kidney, or respiratory function or compromised immune function due to HIV. *\*Akin to a Level 1 Disability Certificate.*

**Voluntary Vaccination:** *\*Requires a separate application before vaccination*

People over 66 years old and have not received the adult pneumococcus vaccine previously.

### **Vaccination Period**

**[Regular Vaccination]** 1) The day before you turn 66 years old

2) The day before you turn 65 years old

**[Voluntary Vaccination]** Until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2027

<b>Type</b>	20-valent pneumococcal vaccine for adults (conjugate vaccine)
<b>Vaccination and Dosage</b>	Covering 20 different serotypes, the vaccine will help the body retain immune memory with just one dose of the vaccine. Long-term effects can be expected.

<b>Co-Pay</b>	4000 yen *Receivers of public welfare assistance are exempt.

## FY2026 Regular Shingles Vaccination for the Elderly

Herpes zoster, or shingles, is a condition when painful strip-like rashes appear on either side of your body accompanied by fluid-filled blisters. One complication that can last even after the skin symptoms go away is called postherpetic neuralgia and may interfere with your daily life. Shingles occurs the most amongst people in their 70s.

**Who is Eligible?:** Residents of Kyotango City and fall under either condition.

- 1) Turning 65, 70, 75, 80, 85, 90, 95, or 100 years old in 2026
- 2) Between 60 and 64 years old with compromised immune function to the point where it is difficult to conduct everyday life activities \*Akin to a Level 1 Disability Certificate

**Vaccination Period:** Until March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2027

### How the Vaccination Will Go:

- 1) For those who fall under condition 1 above, a screening questionnaire, explanation guide, and a list of participating medical providers will be sent to your mailbox at the end of April. Afterwards, please reserve an appointment to the medical provider of your choice.
- 2) Bring your screening questionnaire and a valid ID with you on the day of the appointment. After receiving the vaccine, please pay the copay.
- 3) Receive the Vaccination Completion Certificate.  
\*For those who received the first dose of the recombinant Shingrix vaccine, a screening questionnaire for the second dose will be mailed you at the end of the following month after receiving the first dose.

There are two types of shingles vaccines. You may choose which one you would like to be vaccinated with. *\*You can only get the vaccination once in your lifetime.*

## Major Changes to the Weather Warning and Advisory System

### Easier to Know when to Evacuate

From May, the weather alert and advisory system, which is separated into five levels (special warning/danger warning/warning/advisory), will be numbered according to their level of danger, making it easier to know how it relates to which actions you need to take to be safe. The warnings will be separated into four categories: Flood, Heavy Rain, Landslide, and Storm Surge. Depending on the disaster occurring, the warning will display the level number and the type of warning (emergency warning, urgent warning, warning, advisory) on the message. This naming system differs greatly from the current system, so please make sure to confirm these changes.

## *Let's Not Waste Anything* **Tasty Tidbits of Knowledge**

### **Spring-Harvested Onion and Prosciutto Marinated Salad**



Add this a refreshing side dish!

#### **A versatile spring ingredient – Spring-Harvested Onions!**

Compared your usual supermarket onions, spring-harvested onions are not cured (dried) before they get shipped out for sale and thus have more water content and are suited to be enjoyed raw as they have a milder flavor. If you put them in soup after microwaving them whole, you can easily enjoy a sweet, luxurious soup with all the goodness of this seasonal ingredient!

#### **Tidbit of Trivia**

Onions contain a component called diallyl sulfide that helps keep your blood flowing smoothly and prevent arteriosclerosis. This component is also what gives onions their characteristic spiciness and aroma. Placing sliced onions in water will help lessen its

spiciness, but by doing so, the health benefits also get washed away. Instead, letting the sliced onions sit aside for 15 to 30 minutes can also reduce their spiciness, so you can enjoy them without losing the nutritional benefits!

### Ingredients (serves 2)

Spring-Harvested Onion ..... 1 onion

Prosciutto ..... 50 g

a) Sugar..... 1 tsp

a) Coarsely ground black pepper..... a pinch to taste

a) Lemon juice..... 1 tbsp

a) Olive oil..... 2 tbsp

### Instructions

1) Slice the onion thinly by cutting against the grain.

2) Mix all of the a) ingredients in a bowl, and then add the onion and prosciutto. Toss to combine.

\*You can also add tomatoes or substitute the prosciutto for smoked salmon to level up this recipe! These marinated onions go well with many different ingredients, so have fun with creating your favorite combination! ☆

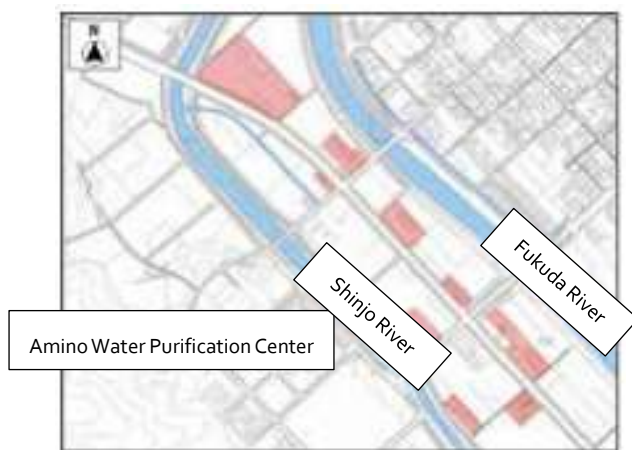

- **To Anyone Planning to Light a Fire**

Up until now, fires could not be lit only on days when a Strong Wind Advisory or Fire Warning was issued. Due to a reform to the local ordinance, fires also cannot be lit on days when a Fire and Field Fire Advisory or Warning is issued. According to the Forest Act, any offence or burn damages afflicted to another individual's forest area may be subject to fines. Before lighting any fires, please make sure to check local weather information and avoid lighting fires on days when the air is dry, windy days, or during long periods without rain. Please cooperate to keep our communities safe.

## Childcare

### ● Childcare Support Allowance to Address Inflation

For guardians raising children from the age of zero to high school age, a Childcare Support Allowance of 20,000 yen per child will be paid out to address the rising costs of goods. Exclusively for Kyotango City residents, the City will add another 5000 yen, making the total allowance 25,000 yen. The allowance will be paid out successively starting in the beginning of March. As a general principle, most households do not need to apply, however a select portion of guardians (such as public servants, etc.) will need to file an application. For more information, please check the website from the QR Code below.

**For Who?** People who fall under the following conditions:

- Guardians who were raising a child eligible to receive Childcare Allowance on September 30<sup>th</sup>, 2025.
- Guardians of children who were born between October 1<sup>st</sup>, 2025 to March 31<sup>st</sup>, 2026.

*\*If either parent is a public servant, the municipality of residence will issue the allowance.*

**Registration:** For those who must apply, please submit the application to either the service window or Citizen's Bureau (except for Mineyama).

### ● Submit a Notice if Using National Health Insurance or Advanced Senior Medical Insurance for Treatment After a Traffic Accident

Any medical treatment for injuries inflicted by a third party from a traffic accident is generally covered by the third party's insurance. However, if you submit a notice to the City, then you can use National Health Insurance or Advanced Senior Medical Insurance to cover your medical treatments.

**Registration:** Please submit the Notice Form (available at the service desk), your personal seal, and Traffic Accident Certificate (in the event of a traffic accident) to the

service desk or Citizen’s Bureau (excluding Mineyama).

**Other:** If using National Health Insurance or Advanced Senior Medical Insurance to cover for medical treatment costs, please submit the Notice to the City before settling the damages. If the damages are settled, the medical costs may not qualify to be covered by insurance.

If insurance is applied without submitting the Notice, the incurred medical fees may be refunded to the insured individual.

For owners who have already registered their dog, the Rabies Vaccination Tag Application should have been sent through the mail. Please fill out the required sections and bring it with you on the day of your dog’s vaccination appointment. Owners may register their dog at any of the Citizen’s Bureaus or at the vet, and dogs may also be vaccinated at the vet. Please vaccinate your beloved pet to protect them and the people around them.
