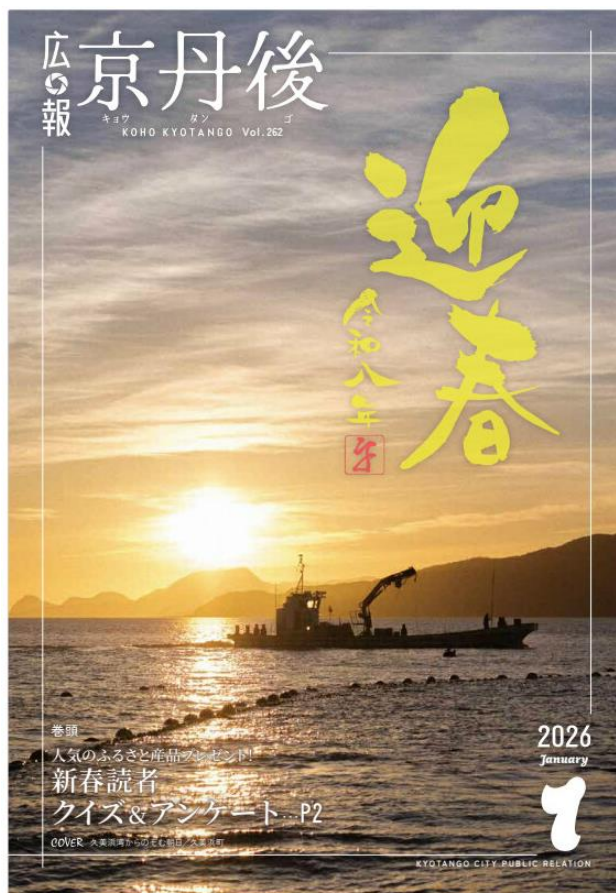

Items to Bring to Your Consultation:

- 1) For district consultations, please prepare your smartphone, My Number Card, and both PIN codes for your My Number Card.
- 2) Withholding Statement (if you have salary or pension income)
- 3) Statement of Earnings and Expenditures and any documents that indicate income amounts and necessary expenditures (if you have income from your business (commercial, agricultural, etc.) or real estate properties).
- 4) Proof of Payment Deduction for National Health Insurance premiums, life insurance premiums, earthquake insurance premiums, or other.

- 5) Itemized bills and receipts for medical fee deductions (if already receiving such deductions previously)
- 6) Itemized list for the Self-Medication Tax Program, Vaccination Completion Certificate (original copy), Health Check Results pamphlet (A copy with the health check results blacked out will be accepted), or other document proving that you conducted “designated efforts” (If you are eligible under the Self-Medication Tax program)
- 7) Bank account number with the filer’s name (if receiving income tax returns), etc.

Organizing your Documents

- ※ If you have income from your business (commercial, agricultural, or other) or real estate properties, please consolidate any documents that show your income amounts and necessary expenditures by category and draft a Statement of Income and Expenditures before coming to a consultation.

Entrance Exam Assistance for Low-Income Households

University Entrance Exam Support Fund

The City will subsidize entrance exam fees for households struggling economically.

Even if the family is not doing well financially, there is a support program for the guardians of exam students who are aiming to get into university or other institution of higher learning. Please check the website for more details.

Who is Eligible?:

Guardians of exam students who have not turned 20 years old by the end of the administrative year and fall under conditions 1 ~ 4.

- 1) The exam student and guardian are registered under the same household.
- 2) In the same application year, all members of the household are exempt from Municipal Taxes.
- 3) All members of the household do not have any outstanding tax payments due to

Kyotango City.

- 4) The household will continue to be registered in the Basic Resident Registry for Kyotango City for at least a year after the date of application.

Assistance Amount:

Up to 53,000 yen per exam student for entrance exam fees for university or other institute of higher learning (includes the University Entrance Common Test, “*kyoutsuu test*”).

Have you gotten your Elderly Shingles Vaccine yet?

Citizens who are eligible to receive their vaccine this year will receive a pre-vaccine questionnaire and explanation in the mail towards the end of April. For more information, please check the city’s website.



※About the Recombinant Vaccine

For the recombinant vaccine (which requires two doses of the vaccine), there needs to be at least a two-month period between the first dose and the second dose. We encourage all eligible individuals to get their vaccine as early as possible, ideally during the month of January. If you receive the second dose past March 31st, then the vaccine will no longer be qualified as a routine vaccination and you will have to cover the full amount for the vaccination dose.

Ex.) 1st Dose received on Jan. 20th → 2nd Dose may be taken from Mar. 20th onwards.

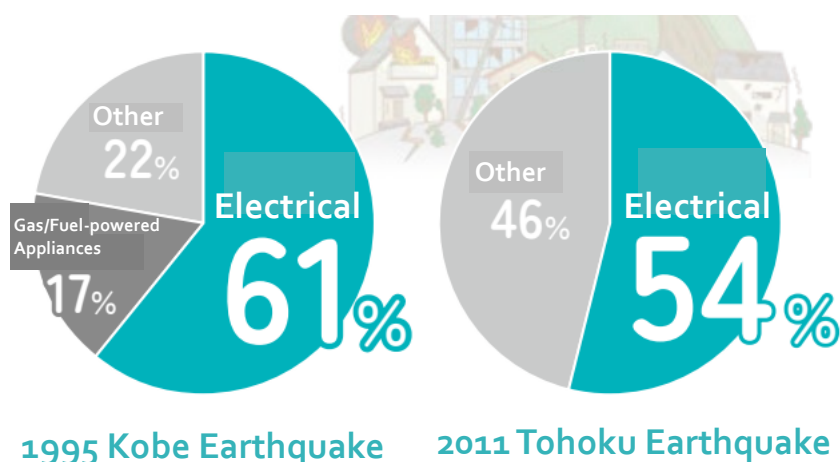
Notice from the Fire Department

Install Seismic Circuit Breakers to Prevent Electrical Fires!

Over half of fires caused by earthquakes are sparked by electricity.

Over half of fire incidents after an earthquake are borne from electrical setups, wiring, or appliances. Looking at past large-scale earthquakes, 85 out of the 139 fires reported after the 1995 Kobe Earthquake (61%) and 58 out of the 108 fires from the 2011 Tohoku Earthquake (54%) were electrical fires.

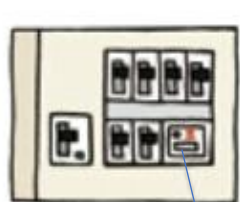

By installing a seismic breaker, you can significantly reduce the risk of fire.

Seismic breakers detect tremors from an earthquake and automatically cut off electricity. For that reason, they reduce the risk of electrical fires. Moreover, there is no need to operate it manually, so installing one can allow you to evacuate quickly out of your home.

Distribution Board Breakers



Seismic sensor

Built-in Type



Retrofitted Type

The sensor detects tremors and shuts down the breaker to cut off electricity.

Simple Circuit Breakers



Weighted Ball/Spring-loaded/Battery-Operated Types

Cuts off electricity if the weighted ball drops or the spring is triggered by tremors.

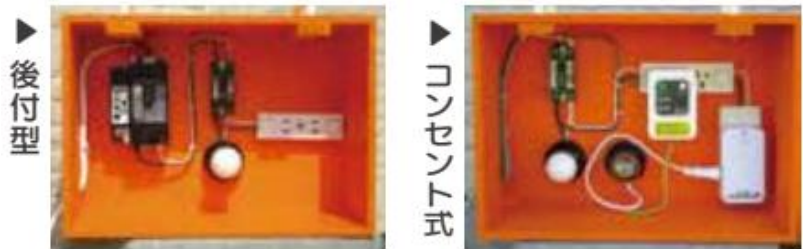


Plug-in Type

Triggers the electrical breaker by short-circuiting the electrical current when a tremor is detected.

Promotion Efforts

The Prevention Office at the Fire & Emergency Department has made a model to demonstrate and educate the public about the importance of seismic breakers. We plan to have the model on display at awareness events, drill trainings, and other such events into the future.

Wintertime Energy-Saving Tips You Can Do at Home!

In the wintertime, energy usage goes up from all of the heating appliances we use to keep us warm. Let's be smart and save our energy to match our lifestyles!

4 Areas to Save!

1) A/C Unit

- Layer up at home and lower the temperature setting.
- Remember to clean the filter regularly!



2) Refrigerator

- Minimize the number of times you open up the fridge, and be careful about your fridge's power setting.
- Do not overpack your fridge.



3) Kotatsu

- Using the blanket cover, make sure to not let the heat escape.



4) Water Heater

- Do not use more hot water than you need.
- Keep your baths short enough so you don't have to use the reheating function.

At city libraries, registered library cardholders must renew their card and reconfirm their personal details once every five years.

Registered personal details include home address, name, and date of birth. When you reconfirm your information, please bring a government-issued I.D. such as your My Number Card, driver's license, residence card, or Certificate of Residence.

About Setting Up Your Password

From the city library website, you can check book availabilities, reserve books, and extend your book loan period. To use this service, you will need to set up a password, so please inform the library counter when creating your password.

Repurpose your New Year's Leftovers!

Black Bean Daifuku

Have fun with different arrangements!

So many ways to enjoy!



Daifuku can change a lot depending on what you put inside of it. Of course, red bean paste is classic, but whipped cream, cheese, and fruit are also fantastic fillings! The combinations are endless, so you can play with different fillings and textures to create your own favorite flavor.

Tidbit of Trivia

"Daifuku" has an auspicious meaning in Japanese which translates to "big" (*dai*) and "fortune" (*fuku*). There is a theory that the word "*daifuku*" was originally written with the characters for "big" (*dai*) and "stomach" (*fuku*) because its shape resembled a large belly. However, the character for belly wasn't very elegant and was changed to the character for fortune instead. Its association as an auspicious food grew stronger, and now is a sweet that's still commonly served at various celebrations.



Ingredients (Makes 4)

Kiri Mochi (50g/piece)... 4 pieces

Water... 100 mL

Sugar...50 g

Simmered sweet black beans (*kuromame*)... 60g

Filling of your choice... Appropriate amount

Potato starch (to coat the mochi) ... As much as you need

Instructions

- 1) Combine the mochi and water in a bowl, cover with plastic wrap, and microwave at 600W for 4 minutes.
- 2) Add sugar and combine until the mixture is slightly translucent. Strain the simmered black beans of their syrup and gently fold them in to the mixture.
- 3) Dust a baking sheet with potato starch and pour out the mixture onto the sheet. Top with another layer of potato starch and cut the mochi mixture into four equal parts. Spread out the mochi mixture with your hands and wrap the filling of your choice inside. Pinch the mochi to close and roll gently in your hands, shaping it into a round ball.

**The mochi may be hard to pinch together, so make sure to remove any extra starch before wrapping in your filling!*
