Changes to City Bus Routes and

Implementation of Mobi Services for Practical Use

On May 13th, a meeting between the City's Regional Public Transportation Council was held at City Hall. At the meeting, the council approved new proposals to change the organization and schedules of Tankai Bus routes that have been affected by a chronic deficiency of bus operators (Mineyama-Yotsutsuji Line, Mineyama-Nobutoshi Line, and the Yasaka-Amino Sakyu Line). Also, Mobi, which has been operating as a demo service



in parts of Omiya and Mineyama since June 2021, was also approved for practical use beginning July 1st.

First, get to a cool place, loosen your clothes, and cool down your body. Then, replenish your body's electrolytes and hydrate with an oral rehydration solution.

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If symptoms persist...

Headache

Vomiting

Fatigue

Lethargy


Reduced Focus



Impaired Judgement

If you can't get yourself to drink water, or you think you can't converse or answer other people's questions well, don't hesitate and call an ambulance! Hurry!





Hydrate and Replenish your Electrolytes!



On hot days, you may sweat a lot. When your body is slightly dehydrated, you may not feel parched, but whether you are indoors or outdoors, make sure to hydrate and replenish your electrolytes frequently. You should be drinking around **1.2 liters of water a day.**

When a **heatstroke alert or a **special heatstroke alert** is in place, please refrain from going outside as much as possible.**

When a special heatstroke alert is issued, an unprecedented heat wave is expected. Refrain from exercising outdoors and practice extra caution in preventing heatstroke. You may also use the cooling shelters at designated community centers and Citizen Bureaus to escape from the heat.
