Renovations on the Suki Danchi Municipal Apartments are Now Complete!



In order to provide a social safety net for our citizens, the City runs and maintains municipal housing for citizens who are struggling economically to find housing, giving them a place to live in peace. This time, the former Omiya Suki Danchi Apartments, which have served the local community for over half a century, were renovated to improve safety and ease of living. The construction project on the apartments have finally been completed and a ceremony was conducted on April 21st, with many of the stakeholders in attendance.

The newly-renovated Suki Danchi Municipal Apartments are replete with improved insulation, renewable energy infrastructure, built with wooden material produced in Kyoto Prefecture, and more. The apartments are also more accessibility-friendly with features such as minimized steps, soundproofing, and handrails, making the apartments suitable for addressing the needs of various types of families, including those with young children.



The City plans to renovate and maintain safe and secure housing into the future for new incoming residents, hopefully promoting future citizens to settle in Kyotango.

Let's Not Waste Anything **Tasty Tidbits of Knowledge**

Super Easy! ☆

Hand-Dripped Coffee Jelly



Enjoy the Possibilities!

Adding milk or coffee creamer is the classic way to enjoy coffee jelly. You can also add depth by topping it off with condensed milk, or even enjoy it with ice cream! ☆

A Tidbit of Trivia

A jelly dessert chock-full with assorted fruits is sure to shine on any dinner table. However, fresh fruits like pineapple and kiwi have enzymes that break down protein, which makes it difficult for the gelatin to set. Some solutions are denaturing the enzymes by cooking the fruits beforehand or using canned fruits instead. Try making a cold jelly dessert that's perfect for the warm days ahead!

Ingredients (serves 1)

Drip Coffee.....1 serving
Powdered Gelatin.....5 g
Sugar.....5 g
Hot Water.....160 ml
Topping of your choice.....To taste

Instructions

- 1) Set the drip coffee filter on top of a heat-resistant cup. Add the powdered gelatin and sugar into the filter.
- 2) Pour the hot water a little at a time and make the coffee.
- 3) After the coffee cools down, cover it with kitchen wrap and place it into the refrigerator to chill and set for 3 hours before serving.

※When making the coffee, pour a little hot water into the center of the filter and wait for

20 seconds to let the coffee aerate. Then, pour the hot water in several rounds as the coffee drips through.

Do You Know the Proper Way to Throw Away Your Diapers?

- 1) Flush the excrement down the toilet and fold the diaper as small as you can with the soiled part folded inwards.
- 2) After putting the diaper in a plastic bag, tie off the top and throw it away in a city-designated trash bag for burnable trash. Make sure to take out the trash on the designated collection day for burnable trash.

Burning trash outdoors (*noyaki*) is forbidden by law. Even if the fire may be an exception acknowledged by the law, please do not burn fires outdoors if there are insufficient protections in place or if there may be complaints from the local community. Changes to City Hall Services

During Evening and Weekend Hours

Do You Know About Thirdhand Smoking?

Even though there may not be a smoker present in the room, have you ever smelled cigarette smoke come into the room or when entering an elevator? The culprit behind that odor is actually the harmful chemicals in cigarette smoke. These harmful chemicals remain on a smoker’s hair, clothes, and even remains on nearby curtains and carpets. Thirdhand smoking (*residual passive smoking*) is when others breathe in these chemicals and it has been reported to have harmful effects to human health. Many smokers probably think that it’s fine to smoke as long as it’s not in front of their family members, but that’s not true. Please take the opportunity to quit smoking for the sake of yourself and your loved ones.

Active Smoking (Firsthand smoking)	You yourself are a smoker and inhaling cigarette smoke directly.
Passive Smoking (Secondhand smoking)	You don't smoke, but you inhale other people's cigarette smoke.
Thirdhand Smoking (Residual passive smoking)	Even if the smoke is gone, you still inhale harmful chemicals from cigarette smoke that is left on the walls or people's clothes.

It's harder than you think to prevent thirdhand smoke!

 <p>What if I use a ventilation fan or an air purifier?</p> <p>It can't get rid of all the harmful chemicals!</p>	 <p>What if I smoke on the balcony?</p> <p>Harmful chemicals will stay in your breath for up to 45 minutes after you're done smoking!</p>	 <p>What about vape-pens or e-cigarettes?</p> <p>Even vape pens and e-cigarettes contain harmful chemicals that spread when you exhale!</p>
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No matter what method you use, you can't prevent it completely!

Be especially careful around small children!

Since children spend a lot of time on the floor, they may be more likely to be exposed to these harmful chemicals. If children are exposed to these chemicals continuously, not only will it cause conditions like allergic reactions and atopic dermatitis, it is also known to cause lasting effects to the brain.

Teach Me, Eco-tan!

Marucchi, a trash bag that hates tedious things, and Eco-tan, a loquacious fairy who knows her stuff about the environment and recycling, have casual chats in this column called, "Teach Me, Eco-tan!" Read on for lots of useful knowledge and info about being eco-friendly!

Part 1 – Know How to Take Your Large Burnable Trash to the Disposal Centers!



M: Hey, Eco-tan. When I was cleaning up after my move, I ended up with a bunch of stuff like old cabinets, futons, and busted-up carpets. Do you know how to throw them away?

E: Let's see. I don't know what a trash bag like you is doing moving houses, but oh well.



That's all large burnable trash, right? Just take it to the Mineyama Clean Center!



M: Okay! I'll just dump it there as is!

E: Hold on just a minute, Marucchi! There are couple things you need to do before throwing them out.



- 1) Make sure to remove non-burnable parts, like metal fixings or glass.
- 2) Cut down wooden furniture so that the parts are under 1 meter long and 20 centimeters thick.



M: Seriously? That sounds like such a drag...

E: It's necessary so that the machines at the Clean Center don't break down while processing your trash! Also, make sure to remove the springs in your mattress and sofa, too.



M: What...? Can you even take those out?

E: Yup, you can! I'll help you out, so let's do it together! The removed metal parts can be recycled too, so you can separate it from the rest of the non-burnable trash.





M: Gotcha! So, I just need to separately sort the metals and large non-burnable trash before bringing it to the Clean Center. I'll be heading out!
