The Man Who Saved Many Lives in Africa Celebrating the Life of Dr. Yuzo Tanigaki as an Honorary Citizen of Kyotango City

Abbreviated Accomplishments of Dr. Yuzo Tanigaki

1967 – Graduates from the Faculty of Medicine at Shinshu University

1979 – Travels the Republic of Niger as a dispatch physician for IRSA (Uranium Mining

Prospect Assessment)

1982 – Appointed as a Medical Expert by JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency) to the National Hospital Surgery Department in Niger.

1992 – Establishes a surgical clinic pilot center in Tessaoua, Niger with his own funds

2001 – Term as a JICA dispatch officer comes to an end and continues his activities in West Africa



with his own funds.

2002 – Closes the former pilot center. Opens a new pilot center in Tessaoua with his own funds

2007 – Compiles the results of his efforts thus far in a proposal written in French

2017 – Laid to rest in Tessaoua (aged 75)

Niger: a desert country located in West Africa. In a foreign land far from Japan, the former Dr. Yuzo Tanigaki, originally from Kyotango, endeavored to establish a proper medical system there. Born and raised in Mineyama, Dr. Tanigaki spent thirty-some years of his career as a doctor in the Niger despite the difficult situation of healthcare in the country. He administered over 12,000 surgeries and dedicated his life making medical contributions and worked to establish self-sustaining, independent medical systems in country's poorest regions.

After reflecting on his life's contributions, Kyotango City will present Dr. Yuzo Tanigaki with the posthumous title of Honorary Citizen. The recommendation was received by the Honorary Citizen Selection Committee on September 24th and then later approved by City Council at an extraordinary council session on October 17th. The honor will be presented at Kyotango City's 20th Anniversary Ceremony on November 3rd.

Hana-Akari is the new tourist train operated by JR West and operates based on the concept of tying together passengers and local service areas as if gathering flowers. The train will run throughout different areas of western Japan for limited periods of time. For the first three-month period from October 5th to December 12th, the Hana-Akari train will make round trips from

Tsuruga Station in Fukui Prefecture through Kyotango on the Kyoto Tango Railway, to Kinosaki Onsen Station in Hyogo Prefecture every Saturday and Sunday. A one-way ride on the train takes about five hours.



Little Bits of Kyotango Knowledge

Savor the Satsuma-imo, the Classic Fall Ingredient

Satsuma-imo, or Japanese sweet potatoes, are high in soluble fibers and contain jalapin, which is effective in promoting digestion and relieving constipation. Plus, sweet potatoes contain as much vitamin C as tangerines which doesn't break down as easily when heated, making it a great food for promoting gut health and beautiful skin. Try out this simple and delicious recipe to make the most out this superb autumn ingredient!

Sweet Potato Yogurt Salad

Ingredients:

Japanese sweet potato ... 100g

Mixed nuts ... 20g

Plain yogurt ... 6og

Mayonnaise ... 1 tsp

Salt and pepper ... to taste

Sugar ... to taste



Instructions:

- 1. Wash the sweet potatoes until they are free of dirt. Keeping the skin on, cut into 2cm cubes and soak in clear water.
- 2. Microwave until tender and cooked through and let cool. (Boiling is also OK)
- 3. Roughly crush the mixed nuts.
- 4. Mix the yogurt and mayonnaise together.
- Combine the cooled sweet potato and nuts with the yogurt mixture and add salt, pepper, and sugar to taste. Serve.
