San'in-Kinki Expressway

City Approves Accelerated Development of the Expressway

The Tango/Regional High-Standard Highway Promotion Council held its regular general meeting on August 29th at the Mineyama Community Center, and was attended by around fifty people involved in the Council. At the meeting, the Council adopted



resolutions such as **connecting the expressway from Omiya Interchange to the borders of the prefecture within the decade following 2028, finalizing plans on implementing the toll fare from the Omiya-Mineyama Interchange to Amino Interchange by the middle of next year (Reiwa 7), and completing the construction of the Omiya-Mineyama expressway and its access roads by Reiwa 8 (2026).** The Council approved of these strong requests with defined timeframes for the completion of the project.

The Forest Environment Tax and the Forest Environment Transfer Tax

A Tax Program to Manage our Often-Neglected Forests

The forests provide us with blessings that affect many facets of our everyday lives. However, as people forget who maintains what part of the forest or forget the boundaries of their private properties, and with fewer people going into forestry, the issues around forest management only grow more serious.

In order to manage neglected forests, there is a new tax category called the **Forest Environment Tax** that has begun in the 2024 fiscal year. From this fiscal year, as a national tax, an annual amount of 1000 yen will be collected from each individual in conjunction with the residence tax. It will be collected as the **Forest Environment**

Transfer Tax (the Forest Environment Tax was initiated first and has been allocated since Reiwa 1), and will be distributed to all prefectural and local governments in Japan. Kyotango City will also use the revenue from the Forest Environment Transfer Tax to finance various initiatives.

Forest Environment Transfer Tax – Initiative 1

➤ **Forest Maintenance**

Using the Forest Management and Control System*, the City manages planted forests that were not been properly maintained before. The City also conducts questionnaires about forest operations, on-site surveys, forest thinning from owners of forested land plots if so requested, as well as other activities.

Forest Environment Transfer Tax – Initiative 2

➤ **Woodworking Classrooms**

To promote the utilization of lumber, Kyotango City will host events where people can experience woodworking with Kyotango-grown lumber. While working with wood, participants learned about the workings of the forest and about the unique characteristics of wood. With the guidance of local craftsmen, children can make wooden crafts using wood and tools.

Forest Management and Control System

In this system, local governments accept requests from owners of forested plots of land and acquires management rights. The government then requests forestry management companies to then manage viable forests for forestry, and unviable forests become publicly managed by the local government.

To Prevent a Bear Encounter

- 1) Avoid going out in the early hours of the morning or at dusk when bears are the most active.
- 2) Keep a bear bell, radio, or a device that makes artificial noises on your person.

If You Do Encounter a Bear

Bears have the behavior to chase after their targets.

- 1) To get away from the bear, back away slowly and do not face your back towards the bear.
- 2) Do not make loud noises as to not startle the bear, and do not run.

To Prevent Bears Getting Close

- 1) Do not leave raw garbage to sit in your yard or throw leftover food into the fields.

- 2) Harvest your persimmons or chestnuts early on and protect the trees with an electrical fence or galvanized iron barrier. Do not leave unharvested crops to sit and deal with them appropriately.

What is Anaphylaxis?

When one eats food that causes an allergic reaction or gets stung by a bee, anaphylaxis is when the body suffers from a serious reaction in a short amount of time. If not treated immediately, it could become a life-threatening situation.

- ☐ Pale Lips or Nails

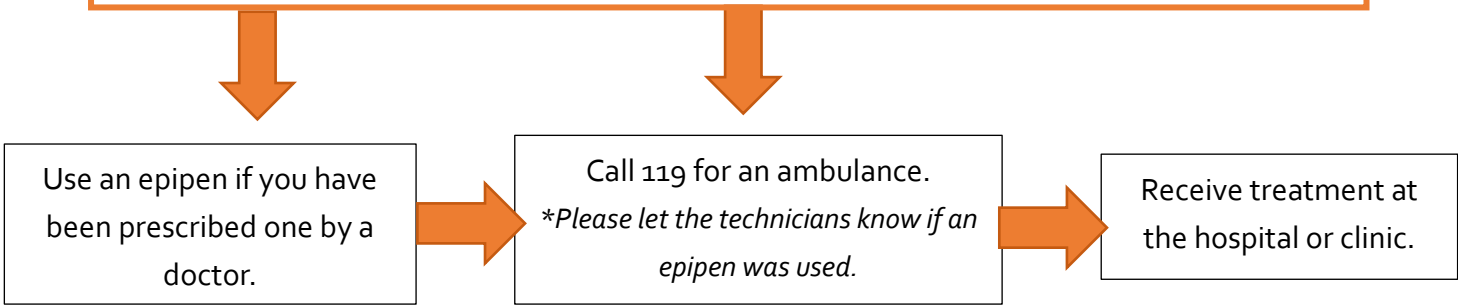
Respiratory Symptoms

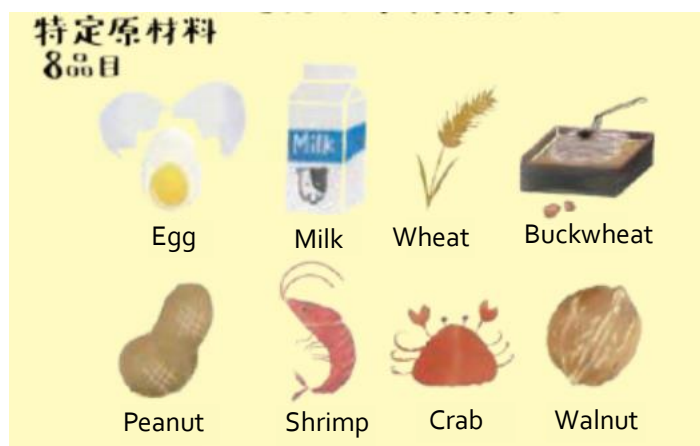

Don't Let Food Go to Waste! Value the Idea of "Mottainai"

Food loss occurs when perfectly edible food is thrown away because its best-by or expiration date has passed or is tossed as leftovers. In Japan, about 5,230,000 tons of food waste* are generated annually. This is equivalent to about 1400 loads in a ten-ton truck. When food is disposed as burnable garbage, the carbon dioxide released from combustion and the resulting ash which needs to be buried only leads to larger environmental issues. In order to reduce food loss as much as we can, let's keep the concept of "*mottainai*" in mind throughout our day-to-day lives. *From 2021

What You Can Do Right Now

When shopping > Don't buy more food than you need. Buy food from the front of the display if you will be eating it soon.

In your refrigerator > Put effort in storing foods appropriately, and keep track of the stored food.

When cooking > Be careful not to trim off too much. Try to use every part of the ingredient in your cooking.

When eating out > Order as much as you can eat and consider taking the leftovers to go.

In the town of Amino lies the Choshiyama Tumulus, the largest keyhole-shaped burial mound along the Sea of Japan coast, the Lake Hanare Burial Mound, which houses a stone coffin said to contain the remains of a king, and the Oka Burial Mound #1, where an ornate bronze sword, decorated with phoenixes, was discovered, among others. These burial mounds tell the tales of distinguished people who once held great power in this area. In the Amino Burial Mound Walking Tour, you will be guided by a specialist working with the City to visit these historic ruins and learn about the ancient history of Amino.

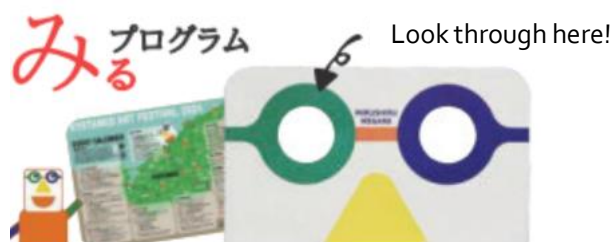
