A space where you can sit and relax while finding useful information from around town.



University Entrance Exam Assistance

There is financial assistance for university exam fees for families who are struggling economically.

For the guardians of students who are thinking about attending university or other institute of higher education but are struggling economically, there is a program that will help pay for the exam fees. Please check the website for more detailed information. Details here:



Who Can Apply?

Guardians of students who are under 20 years of age by the end of the application year and fall under the following four conditions:

- 1. The exam student and the applicant are registered under the same household.**
- 2. Within the application year, all members within the household earn an income that is not taxed the Municipal Tax.**

3. No one in the household has any outstanding tax dues to Kyotango City.
4. By the day of the application, the household has been registered in the Basic Resident Registry for at least a year or longer.

Due Date to Apply

March 31st, 2026

Caution:

- Only one application can be made for an exam student per application cycle.
- When submitting the application, please attach a document that confirms the exam fee amount, a document that confirms that the student took the exam for a university or other institute of higher education, and a document that confirms that the exam fee was paid.

Assistance Amount

Maximum of 53,000 yen per exam student for their university exam fees (includes the University Entrance Common Test (Kyotsuu Test) fee). However, any processing fees incurred when paying the exam fees will not be covered by assistance.

Child Allowance Program

Who Can Apply?

Anyone who is raising a child (up to the first March 31st after the child dependent turns eighteen years old). More details here:



Issuance Period of Assistance

On general principle, the assistance will be issued on every even-numbered month (February, April, June, August, October, and December) and will cover the previous two months.

Amount of Allowance

Age of Child Dependent	Amount of Child Allowance (monthly, per child)
Under 3 years old	15,000 yen (30,000 yen for third child and after)

From 3 to high school age	10,000 yen (30,000 yen for third child and after)
---------------------------	------------------------------------------------------

- The third child and after means the third oldest child and after in a household with multiple child siblings (Child siblings also refers to dependents above the age of majority until March 31st of the year they turn 22 and are also financially dependent on their guardians).

When Applying for Child Allowance

You will need to complete the following procedures to request for child allowance.

- Please apply within the first fifteen days after your child’s date of birth or after completing your move-in procedures.
- If you are late to submit the application, then there will a month where you will not receive child allowance.
- For civil employees, please apply for childcare allowance through your workplace.

When to File a New Application of Recognition

- 1) When a new child is born
- 2) When moving to another town or city
- 3) When a child is under a guardian’s care (i.e. divorce, re-marriage, leaving an orphanage)
- 4) When the guardian is not employed as a civil employee.

When to File an Application to Change the Allowance Amount

- 1) When the number of children has increased due to childbirth while receiving allowance
- 2) When the number of children under your care has changed due to changes in custody and child support payments.

To Keep Receiving Child Allowance Payments

You must submit a Notice of Current Affairs in June of every year.

- The information will be sent out to all applicable persons, so please do not forget to submit the form.
- If a submission is not received, then the child allowance for June and after will not be issued.

Additionally, you will still need to submit paperwork to keep receiving child allowance

for your third child and after who has not turned eighteen by the end of the administrative year.

Vaccine Information for Elderly Citizens

Preventative Vaccinations for Novel Coronavirus and Influenza Virus

Who is Eligible?	<p>Residents of Kyotango City and falls under either one of the following conditions:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. 65 years or older on the day of their vaccination appointment 2. 60 to 64 years old, has impaired functions in their heart, kidneys, or respiratory system, or has a compromised immune system due to the HIV virus or other disease, and has a Disability Certificate Level 1 (A Pre-diagnostic Form will be delivered ahead of time to applicable persons)

How the vaccination process will go:

1. Reserve an appointment at your healthcare institution of choice.
2. Bring your Pre-Vaccination Questionnaire and a form of personal identification to the appointment to receive the vaccine. Pay the co-pay at the institution (unless you are exempt from the co-pay).

*Pre-Vaccination Questionnaires will be available at participating healthcare


facilities in Kyotango City, the Health Promotion Section, and at each Citizens' Bureau beginning at the end of September.

3. After the vaccination, please save the receipt and Proof of Vaccination for your records.

※1. *Households receiving livelihood assistance are exempt from the co-pay.*

※2. *Households exempt from paying Residence Taxes may apply for exemption before their vaccination appointment.*

A flyer detailing vaccination information was sent out with the Japanese version of the newsletter. The application for co-pay exemption is on the back of the flyer. Please bring the completed application with personal identification documents to the Health Promotion Section or the Citizens' Bureau (except for Mineyama) for submission (Please check the flyer for more details).

Tasty Tidbits of Knowledge

A refresher for both your palate and your eyes!

Grilled Eggplant Aspic

Tastes great with both Japanese and Western dishes! Arrange the recipe however you like!

We also recommend making this dish with other vegetables, or with chicken or seafood. The transparent jelly levels up any dish with a cool and refreshing touch. A perfect side to enjoy in the lingering heat of summer!



The dog days aren't over yet...

Ingredients (serves 4):

Water300ml

Gelatin.....10g

Shirodashi seasoning.....45ml

Eggplant.....2 eggplants



Instructions:

- 1) Make the grilled eggplant. (Make five vertical cuts into the eggplant. Grill in a preheated oven to 220°C for 30 minutes. Flip halfway through.)
- 2) Peel the skin of the eggplant and cut into easy-to-eat pieces. Set aside in a Tupperware container.
- 3) In a pot, add water, gelatin, and shirodashi before mixing to combine. Heat until just before the mixture boils. Pour the mixture over the eggplant and let it chill in the refrigerator for at least two hours before serving.

A Tidbit of Trivia

Eggplants: a wonderful vegetable to enjoy in a variety of ways.

If you're going to put it on the dinner table, you definitely want to know how to choose the best eggplants. Look for a fresh calyx (the part that connects to the stem) and a point at the bottom. These are the signs of a fresh eggplant. Eggplants are also said to be 90% water, so make sure the eggplant is firm and heavy. People often think that vegetables that have high water content are low in nutritional value, but eggplants have high nutritional value, are high in fiber and potassium, and are packed with

nutrients that are good for your health!
