## Higiri-Fudosen Festival

**Place:** Nyoiji Temple (1845 Kumihama-cho)

Nyoiji Temple is renown as a flower temple and is famous for three-leaf azaleas (mitsuba-tsutsuji)

which bloom on the hillsides of the temple from mid-April to early May. Take part and experience a Shingon Buddhist rite that prays for good karma and luck to the Buddhist deity, Fudo Myo'o. Every year, many members from the local community come to this springtime ritual. In the morning, the temple priests will conduct a Goma Fire Ritual, followed by a flower sermon in the afternoon.



## O-Fudosan Iwayaji Temple Ritual

**Date:** April 28<sup>th</sup> (Tues.)

**Time:** From 4PM

**Location:** Iwayaji Temple (Taniuchi, Omiya)

**Access:** 7-min drive from Kyotango-Omiya Station, or 15-min walk from the Taniuchi Tankai Bus Stop.



Known by the local community as “O-Fudosan”, Iwayaji Temple houses a sculpture of the Buddhist deity Acala (Fudo) that dates back to feudal Japan. On this day, the monks will chant prayers and perform fire rituals for safety and plentiful harvests.
