**In the event of poor weather, the lesson will be moved to Re:PRISM's Nagaoka studio.*

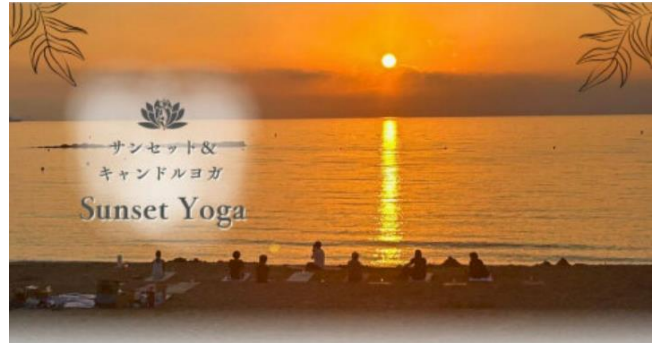
