Location: Taiza, Tango-cho

Route begins at Okanari District
Community Center

Hyakudo-uchi is a traditional ceremonial event that traces back to the Edo Period. While it is still dark and cold, young men from the local community don on colorful sumo aprons and run through the town chanting "Wasshoi, wasshoi!"



to pray for good health and safe households. This event is held twice a year on the Sunday closest to Setsubun, and on the second Sunday of October.
