Suishohama, which means "crystal beach" in Japanese, is named such for its clear blue waters and sparkling crystalline sand; however, trash brought in from the sea currents litters the once-pristine beaches. As the beach is difficult to access by car, the area itself poses challenges for beach cleanups and trash collection and has been a long-standing problem for the local people. With a strong desire from the local community to do something about this problem, the Great Suishohama Beach Cleanup was born! This annual beach cleanup event was started in 2020, and the beach is slowly being restored to its natural beauty with each passing year.

You can also learn about how Japanese art

inspired and propelled the movement of Japonism throughout the Western art world.

Furthermore, you can also observe the fine technology of an 1800-hook Jacquard loom up close.

Come and appreciate the great traditional craft of *Nishijin-ori* through the woven interpretations of Hokusai's *Thirty-six Views of Mount Fuji* and Hiroshige's *Fifty-three Stations of the Tokaido*.
