



- Inside, you can find information about the projected impact from the Gomura Fault, which significantly affects Kyotango City, such as the Seismic Intensity Distribution Map, Total Building Collapses, Liquefaction Hazard Map, and Tsunami Disaster Warning Zones, as well as damage projections for an earthquake on the Yamada Fault.
- The Seismic Intensity Distribution Map, Tsunami Disaster Warning Zones, and other projections may have greater-than-expected damage or area of influence depending on the circumstances.
- For preparations against floods and landslide disasters, please refer to the separately-published Kyotango City Disaster Prevention Map.
